Designed for Police, Probation/Parole, Corrections, Fire, Emergency Medical Specialists, Prosecutors, Military and their supervisors.

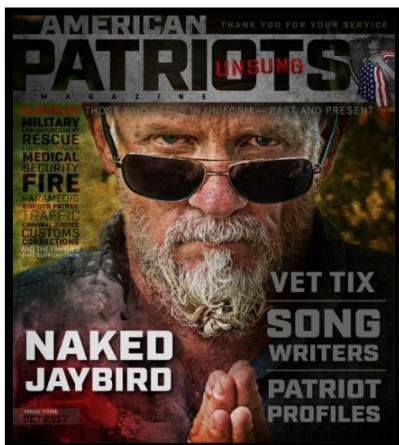

Craig speaks on street culture and violence, himself the warrior-survivor of one of history's most dramatic rip-off assaults.

He tells a story of his life in public service

and how that day in 1995 combined to take a toll on his life and his family. Chris shares how he took control of his suffering in hopes of helping other 1st responders avoid the failure, the pitfalls and to reach out.
